AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS, CONTINUING CHAPTER 34, ARTICLE III, SECTIONS 34-61 THROUGH 34-65 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES PROVIDING CURFEW HOURS FOR MINORS IN THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the safety of children is a public concern; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously passed and adopted a juvenile curfew ordinance that establishes curfew hours for minors and penalties for violations thereof; and,

WHEREAS, such ordinance has been codified in Chapter 34, Article III, Sections 34-61 through 34-65; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 370.002 of the Texas Local Government Code, as amended, provides that the City Council shall review the juvenile curfew ordinance and the conditions the ordinance was intended to remedy three (3) years from its date of passage and every third year thereafter, and conduct public hearings to determine the need to continue, modify or abolish the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has furnished records and reports indicating the need for the juvenile curfew ordinance to remain in effect in order to provide a safe environment for persons under the age of seventeen (17) years; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue the provisions of the Code without any modifications, and schedule the same for review in April of 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS;

Section 1: That the City Council hereby continues, readopts, ratifies, republishes and extends the juvenile curfew ordinance codified in Article III of Chapter 34, Sections 34-61 through 34-65, of the Code of Ordinances, City of Rowlett, Texas.

Section 2: That all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby

other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 34-62(a), OFFENSES, BY PROVIDING FOR PROHIBITED HOURS FOR SATURDAY AND SUNDAY IN VIOLATION OF THE CURFEW FOR JUVENILES; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Article III of the Code of Ordinances provides a curfew for juveniles as defined in Section 34-61 of said article; and

WHEREAS, Section 34-62(a), Offenses, provides the prohibited hours for such curfew; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Section 34-62(a) should be amended to provide prohibited hours for 12:01 a.m. Saturday to 6:00 a.m. on Saturday and 12:01 a.m. Sunday to 6:00 a.m. Sunday.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Section 34-62 of the Rowlett Code of Ordinances be, and the same is, hereby amended by providing for prohibited hours for Saturday and Sunday, which reads as follows:

"Sec. 34-62. Offenses.

(a). . . , or Thursday; and, from 12:01 a.m. Saturday to 6:00 a.m. Saturday and 12:01 a.m. Sunday to 6:00 a.m. Sunday.

(b). . . ."

Section 2: That all provisions of the City of Rowlett Code of Ordinances, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

Section 3: That if any article, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance or the Code of Ordinances, as hereby amended, be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgment or holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4: That all provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Rowlett, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance

shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court of the City of Rowlett, Texas, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and each and every day such violation is continued shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.


Section 6: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.



WHEREAS, Section 370.002 of the TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, as amended, provides that the City Council shall review the Article and conditions the ordinance was intended to remedy three (3) years from its date of passage and every third year thereafter and conduct public hearings to determine the need to continue, modify or abolish the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has furnished records and reports indicating the need for such to remain in effect in order to provide a safe environment for persons under the age of seventeen (17); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue the provisions of the Code without any modifications, and schedule the same for review in April, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the City Council hereby continues, readopts, ratifies, republishes and extends Chapter 34, Article III, Sections 34-61 through 34-65 of the Code of Ordinances for a period of at least three (3) years hence.

Section 2: That all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby

repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Rowlett not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 3. That an offense committed prior to the effective date of this ordinance shall be prosecuted under the prior law and the prior law is continued in effect for this purpose.

Section 4: That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole.


Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.


