FY2022 ARTS IN EDUCATION GRANTS**

Arts in Education Grants provide opportunities for students to view, participate in and understand the creative and performing arts. They are available to public and private schools situated within the territorial limits of the City of Rowlett.

Please note: The total amount of funds available for FY2022 is \$1,000.

These grants can be used to develop new experiences or to support existing programs.

What qualifies for a grant?

- Performances including theater, dance, vocal and instrumental.
- Art exhibits and demonstrations.
- Student workshops in the visual arts, performing arts or humanities.
- Author lectures.

What does not qualify for funding?

- Courses of academic credit.
- Capital improvements or operating expenses.
- Scholarships
- Fundraisers and profit-making projects.
- Social functions, parties or receptions.
- Projects by privately owned for-profit corporations.
- Retroactive funding requests.
- Debt reduction.
- Projects that include obscene material as defined in Texas Penal Code section 43.21.

Criteria for selection will be based on Artistic Merit, Community Value, Feasibility of Project, and Educational Benefit.
